PROBLEM:

Most self-gripping pliers can cause hand injuries due to cumbersome designs.

- Bulky jaws prevent access to tight spots.
- Position setting is easily lost when the tool is set aside.



SOLUTION:

Multipurpose Self-Gripping Pliers

- Parallel jaw design ensures non-slip grip on round, hexagonal, and square workpieces.
- Uses extra-thin jaws for easy access into tight work areas.
- Locking mechanism retains set position until readjusted on all but 9-position pliers.
- One-handed sizing on all but 9-position pliers.
- Safety stop prevents hand pinching.
- Available in 9, 11, 18, 20, 25, 27, and 30-position models.
- Balanced and lightweight for minimum fatigue.
